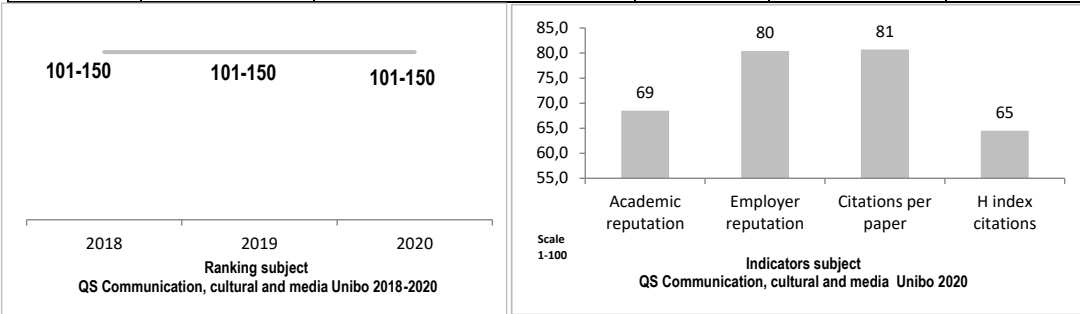

The estimated contribution of the **DAR** department to Subject **Communication, cultural and media** is **significant** but not prevalent. DAR could use the QS label in its external communications, declaring the department's level of contribution.

#### PROCEDURE ADOPTED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE FOR QUALITY ASSURANCE TO ESTIMATE THE CONTRIBUTION OF EACH DEPARTMENT

-Analysis of the population of each department (31 December 2019) and of the SSDs of each researcher (professors and researchers on permanent and fixed-term contracts);

-identification by the Executive Committee for quality assurance of the SSDs that characterise each subject (on a scale from 0 to 10);

-identification of each department's level of contribution to each subject according to this scheme::

**PREVALENT** accounts for at least 50% of the scores related to the university's research staff belonging to the SSDs associated with the subject;

**SIGNIFICANT BUT NOT PREVALENT** accounts for at least 50% of the scores related to the university's research staff belonging to the SSDs associated with the subject;

**MINOR BUT PERTINENT** accounts for less than 20% of the scores related to the university's research staff belonging to the SSDs associated with the subject.

No mention is given to subjects unrelated to at least 4 research staff. And, the subjects in which the university has not been.
